
## Things you will need

- 2 Boxes (1 shoebox or tissue box, and 1 smaller box)
- 3 Toilet or kitchen paper tubes
- 2 drinking straws
- · Acrylic paint, Crayons or colored pencils
- · White glue or hot glue gun
- Paint brush



## **Safety First**

- Keep the glue gun out of young children's reach.
- Watch out for this sign 1. It means that an adults help may be needed for this step.



A shoebox or a tissue box can be used as Kenny's main

body. (If you're using a shoebox, glue the lid onto the box.) Cut and fold to give the slanted back to the Kenny's truck body (see the dotted line above). Use a smaller box for Kenny's cab section. Use white glue or a hot glue gun to connect the two boxes.



Cut out 2 circles for each wheel. *One that is slightly larger than your kitchen roll and the other the same size.*Glue the two pieces together. Paint them to look like tyres.

Note: you'll need 6 in total for the 3 sets of wheels.




When the wheels are dry glue them to the kitchen roll to form 3 sets of wheels.



Draw and colour your own KWD signs and "KENNY" number plate and stick them onto Kenny's truck. Paint your drinking straws and stick them on. Paint on your windows to the cab section.



Paint your Kenny truck body and cab. Get creative and design your own style of KWD Kenny truck!



When your Kenny truck is painted and dry, turn it upside down and glue your sets of wheels to it. Two sets under the body and one set under the cab.



Now draw eyes and a mouth and there you have it....your very own Kenny KWD Recycling Truck!
